

Executing God's plans: 04 things to do

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Text from Actes 18:9

God has wonderful plans for each of his children. He says in his Word

To carry out God's plans for our lives, here are 04 things to do. The aim is to resist the devil and not be afraid to do what God wants us to do.

Trust in God

First and foremost, a Christian must trust in God. Trusting in God testifies to our faith, to our belonging to Him, and removes from us the feeling of fear. This feeling (fear) is the element most often used by the enemy to dissuade us from doing God's will. That's why, if we trust in God, we can easily and fearlessly do what is required of us. Turn to God's Word

The Word of God is life for those who hear it and receive it into their hearts. An indispensable element for the accomplishment of God's works in the lives of His children, the Word has the power of resurrection, healing and salvation for all who believe in it.
